and employees.

3. During the course of this litigation, I have closely supervised administration of

Wheaton College's insurance plans. As a result of my supervision, I know the

"accommodation" coverage is not currently being provided, and has not been

provided at any time, in connection with Wheaton College's plans.

4. That said, it is also my understanding that the government is pressuring our

contract partners to provide this coverage in connection with Wheaton's plans

over Wheaton's religious objection. That is why we continue to respectfully re-

quest and need injunctive relief against the government's ongoing efforts to

use our plans in this manner.
